Commentary

At 8+ 29% above national averages in LCT, 41% in LSL, 50% in Reading and 40% in Writing. At 8+ 39% above national averages in NLC, 43% in CALC and 44% in SSM. Nearly all our children achieve national averages of 6+

A Reception child is expected to achieve 78 points or 6+ in all the Early Years Goals. Our children's average point score was 101 and nearly three quarters of our pupils achieve 8+ which is approaching National Curriculum targets.

Commentary Yr 2 national average L2b

At L3 Reading 33% above national average with 100% L2+ compared to 87% nationally. At expected writing levels 32% above national average with 100% at L2+ compared to 83% nationally. At L3 Maths 55% above national average with 100% L2+ compared to 91% nationally. Overall steady trend well above national average. Average point score equal to national average for Yr 3 and 4 pupils. All Literacy/Maths results are **significantly** above the national average, along with Average points scores for the last five years.

Phonics Screening Yr 1

A national phonics screening test was introduced for Yr 1 pupils this year. The national pass rate was 32 words out of 40. 79% of our pupils attained the pass rate compared to 59% nationally.

At L4 Reading and Writing 30%+ above LA average. At L4 Maths, 39% above LA average.

Nearly all our pupils achieve national averages.

Overall trend maintained well above average. Average point score equal to national average for Yr 5 and 6 pupils. All Literacy/Maths results are **significantly** above the national average, along with Average points scores for the last five years.

Considering the results are well above average at Early Years and KS1, to maintain this level of progress and more is exceptional!
